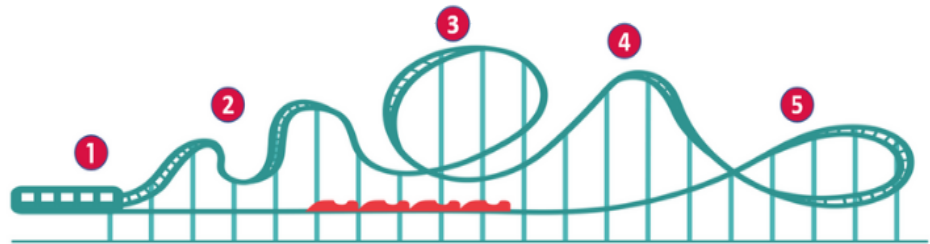

1 DEVELOPING YOUR QUESTION

Are you just beginning to think about your research question and the kind of evidence you might need? Librarians can help you get a feel for the evidence that is out there on your topic, which can help you shape your question and begin identifying the key terms that will make your in depth searching much easier.



2 STARTING YOUR SEARCH

Librarians can help you get a good start on identifying most of the key terms you'll need, select the databases that will give you the best results, show you how to put the terms together to find articles, and you'll walk away

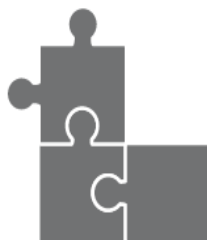
3 READING, EVALUATING, SELECTING

The amount of information out there can be very overwhelming. Sometimes even figuring out which articles are relevant to your topic is a challenge. Librarians can help you clarify the concepts you want to address in your literature review and look at titles and abstracts to determine whether the articles you're finding are the best evidence for you.



4 ORGANIZING

Are your articles scattered all over your bedroom floor (or your computer)? Are you having trouble making comparisons between articles? A librarian can help by showing you systems for storing and organizing your articles as well as compiling details about the evidence so that the information is at your fingertips.



5 SYNTHESIZING

Librarians can help you separate background information from the primary evidence and then figure out how to bring all of your evidence together so that your lit review can flow smoothly.
