
Why We Do Activity Reporting

Required by:

- Federal Government
 - Meets OMB and NIH, NSF requirements
- Illinois Board of Higher Education Cost Study
 - Gathers credit hours by student level and Costs associated with Instruction, Organized research, Public service
 - Calculates cost of instruction per credit hour and administrative costs accumulated by level
 - Compares Illinois universities at institutional, discipline and program level.




The ARS Data Collection Process




How ARS Data is Used at UIC
