



# **Disability & Gender wise details) December 2014 to March 2015**







The teachers of these schools are oriented periodically on identification of special needs in children, consequent supports like referral services, curricular adaptation and management, and guidance regarding availing educational welfare measures among others. Beyond these, need-based guidance is extended to teachers in managing practical hitches in the process of inclusion.
