The restrict access feature enables teachers to restrict the availability of any activity or even a course section according to certain conditions such as dates, grade obtained, group or activity completion.

- The activity **Choose how to progress through the course** is marked complete (hidden otherwise)
- Any of (hidden otherwise):

 - You belong to **All at once**
- It is after **7 January 2019, 12:05 AM** (hidden otherwise)

Restrict access is enabled by default in new installations of Moodle 3.1 onwards.

Note: If you don't see a 'Restrict access' option when setting up course activities and sections, check with the administrator that it is enabled in *Site administration* > *Advanced features*.
