I Diploma Programmes

1. Diploma in Hearing Aid and Ear Mould Technology (DHA & ET) (Recognized by RCI)

Duration of the Programme	: One year
Total number of Seats	: 25

This programme aims at training the students in the maintenance and repair of hearing aids as well as in ear mould technology. The focus is more on practical training and the student trainees are given hands-on experience in the repair of different types of hearing aids and preparation of ear moulds.

Admission Eligibility

- 1. Admission to Diploma in Hearing Aid and Ear mould Technology is open to candidates who have *passed 12th standard / II PUC with Physics* background or any Diploma in Electronics/Electrical or ITI Electronics/Electrical or Dental technician course.
- 2. Candidates should have obtained a minimum of 50% of the aggregate (45% for SC/ST) in the qualifying examination.
- 3. Candidates who are < 24 years on the 1st July of the year of admission

Mode of Selection

Selection is purely on the basis of merit. The marks obtained in the qualifying examination will be considered for selection of candidates. A weightage of 2% will be given for the candidates with graduate or postgraduate degrees.

Stipend: Students admitted to the Diploma programme (DHA & ET) will be given a stipend of ₹ 250/- per month for 10 months.

2. Diploma in Early Childhood Special Education (Hearing Impairment) (Recognized by RCI)

Duration of the Programme	: One year
Total number of Seats	: 25

This diploma programme helps in generating manpower that will cater to the needs of children with hearing impairment below 3 years of age and their caregivers. Those trained would be able to help children with hearing impairment to be equipped with pre-school, pre-academic skills. This would enable these children to learn a school curriculum more easily. Thus, those who undergo the DECSE(HI) programme would be required to help to train children with hearing impairment before they are admitted to school making it possible to enable the children to study in regular schools along children with normal hearing.

Admission Eligibility

- 1. Admission to DECSE(HI) is open to candidates who have passed 12th standard / II PUC or equivalent education from any recognized board.
- 2. Candidates should have obtained a minimum of 50% of the aggregate (45% for SC/ST) in the qualifying examination.
- 3. Candidates should be above 17 years of age.

Preference will be given to (a) graduates, (b) 12th standard / II PUC pass with training in Montessori/ kindergarten / early childhood education (c) parents, siblings and family members of children with hearing impairment who satisfy the prescribed qualification.

Mode of Selection

Selection will be purely on the basis of marks obtained in the qualifying examination. A weightage of 2% will be given for the candidates with graduate or postgraduate degrees.

Stipend: Students admitted to the DECSE(HI) Programme will be given a stipend of \gtrless 250/- per month for 10 months.

3. Diploma in Hearing, Language and Speech (DHLS) through Video-Conferencing mode (Recognized by RCI)

Duration of the Programme	: One year
Total number of Seats	: 25 (for each study center)

This programme is designed to generate manpower that will cater to the needs of individuals with communication disorders at the grass-root level. In this programme, the students are trained to identify individuals with communication disorders and make appropriate referrals for further diagnosis. The students are also trained to supervise the caregivers in following the guidelines given by professionals for rehabilitation. Extensive practical training is given to supplement the theoretical knowledge.

The programme is conducted at the All India Institute of Speech and Hearing, Mysuru along with eight other study centres across the country. Theory classes will be conducted at the AIISH which is beamed real time to the study centres through video-conferencing. Practical classes will be conducted at each study centre which will be supervised by the staff of the centre.

- 2. Candidates should have obtained a minimum of 50% of the aggregate (45% for SC/ST) in the qualifying examination.
- 3. Candidates who are < 21 years on the 1st July of the year of admission
- 4. Candidates should have working knowledge in English and proficiency in their regional language.

Preference will be given to candidates from rural areas, sponsored candidates from Government/ non-government/voluntary agencies.

Applications should be sent to the respective Institute / Study Centres. Interview/counselling will be done at the respective Institute / Study Centres.

Mode of Selection

Selection is purely on the basis of merit. The marks obtained in the qualifying examination will be considered for selection of candidates. A weightage of 2% will be given for the candidates with graduate degree.

Stipend: Students admitted to the DHLS Programme will be given a stipend of **Rs.250/-** per month for 10 months.

II Bachelor Degree Programmes

1. Bachelor of Audiology and Speech Language Pathology (B.ASLP) (Affiliated to University of Mysore & Recognized by RCI)

Duration of the Programme	: Four years (6 semesters plus 1 year internship)
Total number of Seats	: 62 at AIISH
	: 10 at NSCBMC, Jabalpur

The undergraduate students of B.ASLP/BASLP learn about the normal aspects and disorders of speech, language and hearing. The students are trained in evaluation, diagnosis, treatment and management of communication disorders. The training includes theoretical and practical aspects, with focus on clinical teaching-learning. The students get hands-on experience in dealing with clients under the supervision of qualified staff.

Admission Eligibility

- 1. Admission to B.ASLP/BASLP is open to candidates who have passed the 2-year Pre-University examination conducted by the Pre-University Board of the State of Karnataka or any other examination (10+2) considered as equivalent thereto by the University of Mysore.
- 2. Candidates who have obtained a minimum of 50% (45% for SC/ST) in the PCMB group or combinations thereof, in their II PUC or qualifying examination are eligible for admission.
- 3. Only those candidates who have studied **at least three subjects** from among Physics, Chemistry, Biology and Mathematics are eligible for admission.

Mode of Selection

An all India entrance examination will be conducted for admission to the B.ASLP programme at various centres. The entrance exam scores are valid for admission to BASLP Programme offered at Netaji Subhash Chandra Bose Medical College (NSCBMC), Jabalpur. *Further, selection process at NSCBMC is as per their admission rules*.

All the students **except those applying under the foreign quota**, will have to write the entrance examination in **3 of the 4 subjects**, i.e., *Physics and Chemistry as compulsory subjects and either Biology or Mathematics*, which is based on the CBSE syllabus of 11th and 12th standards. In addition, the candidate who has studied Biology or Mathematics/ Computer Science/ Electronics/ Psychology would be eligible to apply for admissions to B. ASLP programme. Therefore, a candidate will take entrance examination in PCM or PCB and not in any other combinations.

Admission will be made on the basis of percentile rank in the entrance examination and in accordance with AIISH regulations governing the conduct of entrance examination. The number of questions to be answered shall be 50 in 50 minutes duration, in each subject. For foreign candidates, the selection is made on the basis of marks in the science subjects in the qualifying examination, subject to meeting eligibility requirements and equivalence criteria of University of Mysore. In the event of tie, candidates who appeared for Biology paper in the entrance examination will get preference. In the event of a tie even after the above conditions, the age of the candidate shall decide the ranking. Students who are older will be placed higher.

The objective of this certificate programme is to enlighten the caregivers on disabilities and also to serve as aides to professionals in the care of their own or other similar children with disabilities. The programme also intends to enhance caregiver competencies in day-to-day handling of such children. It has scope for community work in the area of disability too.

Admission Eligibility

- 1. SSLC or its equivalent from any recognized board with ability to read and write any native language.
- 2. Parents or caregivers of children with disabilities will be preferred.

Medium of Instruction

The program is available through open book learning system. Medium of instruction available currently is Kannada, English and Hindi.

Course Structure and Duration

The academic session shall extend over a minimum period of 14 weeks (3 $\frac{1}{2}$ calendar months). The time schedule of the program is as follows:

Instructions for Entrance Examination

A. B.ASLP / BASLP

- 1. The syllabus for the entrance examination shall be CBSE (Class XI and XII)
- 2. The examination will be conducted in four subjects namely, Physics, Chemistry, Biology and Mathematics. All the students except those applying under the foreign quota, will have to write the entrance examination in 3 of the 4 subjects, i.e., *Physics and Chemistry as compulsory subjects and either Biology or Mathematics*, which is based on the CBSE syllabus of 11th and 12th standards. In addition, the candidate who has studied Biology or Mathematics/ Computer Science/ Electronics/ Psychology would be eligible to apply for admissions to B.ASLP programme. Therefore, a candidate will take entrance examination in PCM or PCB and not in any other combinations.

Note: The three papers chosen by the candidate should be clearly indicated in the admission ticket.

- 3. The examination is conducted in English.
- 4. The duration of each paper shall be 50 minutes with an additional 10 minutes for reading instructions and filling-up of personal details in the answer sheet.
- 5. Students have to answer 50 questions of multiple choice types, each carrying one mark, on a specially designed answer sheet which will be scanned and processed on a computer. Answers are to be marked using **BLACK BALL POINT PEN** only.
- 6. The candidate must **retain a photocopy of his/her application form and the receipt**, counterfoil of payment for future correspondence and for availing duplicate hall ticket, if required.
- 7. Under no circumstances re-examination will be conducted for those who fail to appear for the entrance examination on the scheduled date and time.
- 8. The candidates have to bring their admit card on the day of the entrance examination, without which they will not be permitted to take up the entrance examination.
- 9. Computerized valuation will be carried out.
- 10. There is no negative marking for wrong answers for B.ASLP / BASLP program.
- 11. If more than one answer is indicated against a question, no marks will be awarded for the same.
- 12. Any form of overwriting and erasing on the answer sheets will be processed by the computer as an incorrect answer.
- 13. Based on the total marks obtained in the three subjects taken by the students, a merit list will be generated on percentile basis.
- 14. In case two or more candidates obtain same percentile (tie) in the entrance exam, then inter-se merit of such candidates shall be determined as follows:
 - (a) Candidates who appeared for Biology paper of the entrance examination will get preference followed by Physics, Chemistry and the relative position of the two candidates will be decided on the marks obtained in these subjects.
 - (b) In case of a tie even after the above conditions, the age of the candidate shall decide the ranking. Students who are older will be placed higher.

- 15. Verification of the documents will be done at the time of counselling / admission.
- 16. There is no provision for revaluation of answer sheets.
- 17. The All India Rank list will be announced on 1st June 2018. The results will be put on our website: <u>www.aiishmysore.in</u> along with the answer keys. - 3. Students appearing for both M.Sc. (Speech-Language Pathology) and M.Sc. (Audiology) have an option to take either of the exam they wish to write at 9.30 a.m.
- 4. Students have to answer 100 questions of multiple choice types, each carrying one mark on a OMR sheet which will be scanned and processed on a computer.
- 5. The candidates have to bring their admit card on the day of the entrance examination, without which they will not be permitted to take up the entrance examination.
- 6. Answers are to be marked using **BLACK BALL POINT PEN ONLY.**
- 7. Any form of overwriting and erasing in the answer sheets will be processed as incorrect answers.
- 8. There is negative marking for wrong answers calculated @ -0.25 marks per wrong answer.
- 9. If more than one answer is indicated against a question it will be processed as incorrect and **negative marks** will be awarded for the same.
- 10. The examination shall be conducted in Speech-Language Pathology for M.Sc. (Speech-Language Pathology), Audiology for applicants to M.Sc. (Audiology) covering the B.Sc. (Sp. & Hg.) / B.ASLP syllabus.
- 11. English is the medium of examination.
- 12. Under no circumstances will re-examination be conducted for those who fail to appear for the entrance examination on the scheduled date and time.

- 13. There is no provision for revaluation of answer sheets.
- 14. In case two or more candidates obtain same percentile (tie) in the entrance examination then inter-se merit of such candidates shall be determined as follows:
 - a) Aggregate of all the three years/6 semesters of the Bachelor's programme will be considered.
 - b) If there is a tie even after this, then marks of the final year shall be considered.
 - c) In case of a tie even after the above conditions, the age of the candidate shall decide the ranking. Students who are older will be placed higher.
- 15. Verification of documents will be done at the time of counselling/admission.
- 16. The select list will be announced on 1st June 2018 for M.Sc.(SLP/Aud). The candidates must be prepared to join the programme immediately.



AIISH GENESIS AND GROWTH

The All India Institute of Speech and Hearing is a premier Institute in the country imparting training in the field of Speech and Hearing. Established on 9th August, 1965 as an autonomous organization, AIISH caters to manpower generation in the field, promoting research and providing rehabilitation services in the area. The Institute is located on a sprawling area of 32 acres (two campuses) in Mysore.

The Institute is registered as a Society under the Societies Registration Act XXI of 1860 (Punjab Amendment) Act, 1957 and is functioning as an autonomous body under the aegis of the Union Ministry of Health and Family Welfare.

Established primarily as a training institute, it started training programs at postgraduate level in 1967 followed by B.Sc. (Speech and Hearing) in 1968. The institute now offers 17 programmes. These include one certificate programme, three diploma programmes [Diploma in Hearing Aid & Ear mould Technology, Diploma in Early Childhood Special Education (Hearing Impairment) and Diploma in Hearing Language and Speech-through video conferencing model; two undergraduate programmes [Bachelor of Audiology and Speech Language Pathology (B.ASLP) and Bachelor of Education Special Education (Hearing Impairment)]; four PG Diploma programmes [Clinical Linguistics, Neuroaudiology, Augmentative and Alternative Communication, and Forensic Speech Sciences and Technology]; three post graduate programmes [M.Sc. (Audiology), M.Sc. (Speech-Language Pathology) and M.Ed. Spl.Ed. (Hearing Impairment)]. In addition, it offers three Ph.D. programmes [Audiology, Speech-Language Pathology, and Speech and Hearing] and Post-Doctoral Fellowship. The Institute also conducts short term training and orientation programs for professionals in allied specialties.

AIISH is recognized as a reputed organization for capacity building in the field of speech and hearing and related areas throughout the country. The Institute has been recognized as a Centre of Excellence in the Area of Deafness (WHO), as a Centre for Advanced Research (UGC) and as a Science and Technology Institute (DST). The Institute is affiliated to the University of Mysore for the award of degrees. The academic programs of the institute have the recognition of the Rehabilitation Council of India, a statutory body in the area of rehabilitation sciences.

The Institute is wholly financed by the Government of India. The functioning of the Institute is under the direction of the Executive Council with the Hon'ble Union Minister for Health and Family Welfare as the Chairman and the Hon'ble Minister of Health and Family Welfare, Government of Karnataka, as the Vice-Chairman. The other statutory bodies of the Institute are the Finance Committee and the Academic Committee.
