This Ministry is examining a proposal for amendment to Indian Bureau of Mines (class I and II posts) Recruitment Rules 1976 in so far as they related to the post of Librarian and Indian Bureau of Mines, and Indian Bureau of Mines (class I and II posts) Recruitment Rules 1964 in so far as they related to the post of Deputy Librarian, for the existing posts of Assistant Library and Information Officer and Senior Library and Information Assistant, a Subordinate of office under the Ministry of Mines. In this regard, draft Recruitment Rules have been prepared and enclosed herewith.

2. Before taking up the proposal for amendment to the Recruitment Rules with the DoP&T, UPSC and other agencies for finalizing the Recruitment Rules, comments, if any, are invited from all stakeholders in the matter within a period of thirty days from the date of notification in the website of the Ministry of Mines and Indian Bureau of Mines. The objections/suggestions received from the stakeholders within the specified period shall be considered by the Ministry as per rules/requirement.

G.S.R. .—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution, and in supersession of Indian Bureau of Mines (class I and II posts) Recruitment Rules 1976 in so far as they related to the post of Librarian and Indian Bureau of Mines, and Indian Bureau of Mines (class I and II posts) Recruitment Rules 1964 in so far as they related to the post of Deputy Librarian, except as respects things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the post of Assistant Library and Information Officer and Senior Library and Information Assistant in Indian Bureau of Mines, Ministry of Mines, namely:—

1. Short title and commencement.— (1) These rules may be called Ministry of Mines, Indian Bureau of Mines Assistant Library and Information Officer and Senior Library and Information Assistant (Group 'B' Posts), Recruitment Rules 2019.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. Application.—These rules shall apply to the posts specified in column (1) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.

3. Number of posts, classification and Level in the Pay Matrix.—The number of the said posts, their classification and the pay levels in the pay matrix attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the said Schedule.

4. Method of recruitment, age-limit, qualifications, etc.— The method of recruitment, age-limit, qualifications and other matters relating to the said post shall be as specified in columns (5) to (13) of the said Schedule.

5. Disqualifications— No person,-

- (a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or
 - (b) who having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,
- shall be eligible for appointment to the said posts:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

6. Power to relax.—Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

7. Saving.—Nothing in these rules shall affect reservation, relaxation of age-limit, and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, the Other Backward Classes, Ex-service men and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.
