NOTIFICATION

New Delhi, the 22nd November, 2012

G.S.R. 293.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution, and in supersession of the Ministry of Industry and Supply (Department of Industry) Chief Librarian and Librarian (Recruitment) Rules, 1964, except as respects things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the President hereby makes the following rules to regulate the recruitment to the posts of Principal Library and Information Officer and Director and Assistant Library and Information Officer in the Department of Industrial Policy and Promotion under the Ministry of Commerce and Industry, namely :—

1. Short title and commencement.—(1) These rules may be called the Ministry of Commerce and Industry, Department of Industrial Policy and Promotion (Principal Library and Information Officer and Director and Assistant Library and Information Officer) Recruitment Rules, 2012.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. Number of posts, classification and scale of pay.—The number of the said posts, their classification and the Pay band and Grade pay or pay scale attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.

3. Method of recruitment, age limit and other qualifications, etc.—The method of recruitment, age limit, qualification and other matters relating to the said posts shall be specified in columns (5) to (13) of the schedule aforesaid.

4. Disqualifications.—No person,—

(a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or

(b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,

shall be eligible for appointment to the posts :

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

5. Power to relax.—Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order in consultation with the Union Public Service Commission and for reasons to be recorded in writing relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

6. Saving.—Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, and other concessions required to be provided for Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, Other Backward Classes, Ex-servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

Library and Information Assistant (Pay band-2, pay scale of rupees 9300—34800 with grade pay rupees 4200) with five years' regular service in the grade and has successfully undergone mandatory training prescribed by the Department.

Note 1.—Where juniors who have completed their qualifying or eligibility service are being considered for promotion, their seniors would also be considered provided they are not short of the requisite qualifying or eligibility service by more than half of such qualifying or eligibility service or two years, whichever is less, and have successfully completed their probation period for promotion to the next higher grade, alongwith their juniors who have already completed such qualifying or eligibility service.

Note 2.—For the purpose of computing minimum qualifying service for promotion, the service rendered on a regular basis by an officer prior to 1st January, 2006 (the date from which the revised pay structure, based on the sixth Central Pay Commission recommendations has been extended) shall be deemed to be service rendered in the corresponding grade pay and pay scale extended based on the recommendations of the pay commission.

Note 1.—Period of deputation including period of deputation in another ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or some other Organisation or Department of the Central Government, shall ordinarily not exceed three years. The maximum age limit for appointment by deputation shall be not exceeding fifty six years as on the closing date of the receipt of applications.

Note 2.—For the purpose of appointment on deputation basis, the service rendered on a regular basis by an officer prior to 1st January, 2006 (the date from which the revised pay structure based on the 6th Central Pay Commission recommendations has been extended) shall be deemed to be service rendered in corresponding grade pay and pay scale extended based on the recommendations of the Pay Commission except where there has been merger of more than one pre-revised scale of pay into one grade with a common grade pay and pay scale, and where this benefit will extend only for the post for which that grade pay and pay scale is the normal replacement grade without any upgradation.
