Science Citation Searching

The electronic version of the "Science Citation Index" of ISI (American Institute for Scientific Information) with additional citations from ISI's Current Contents series of publications is available on STN International. SciSearch

draws information from 4500 scientific journals. This makes it one of the world's largest multidisciplinary scientific literature databases.

A tabular format of cited references in SciSearch makes it easy to read an analysis of the references. "SELECT" allows statistical analysis of the citations, for instance, to determine which authors and papers are cited most often. In SciSearch one can conduct a search on a particular topic, select the cited references from the answers and rank them by number of occurrences to see which are being referenced the most (bibliometric measurement).
