- 1. Testing of referred clinical specimens was considered on the basis of request/referral received from through state surveillance officer(SSO) of concerned State Integrated Disease Surveillance Programme / any other health care facility affirming requirements of the case definition's
- 2. A single negative test result, particularly if this is from an upper respiratory tract specimen does not exclude infection*
- 3. A positive test result is only tentative and will be reconfirmed by retesting
- 4. Repeat sampling and testing of lowed respiratory specimen is strongly recommended in severe or progressive disease. The repeat specimens may be considered after a gap of 2-4 days after the collection of the first specimen for additional test if required*
- A positive alternate pathogen does not necessarily rule out either, as little is yet known about the role of co infections.
