## Submitted to the Director

Sub: Counting of past service for the period from 9.3.2001 to 13.12.2010 for the purpose of pensionary benefits at AIISH, Mysuru.

## Respected Madam,

In continuation of my previous request on the subject mentioned above, I would like to place the following for your kind consideration.

- 1. Prior to joining with AIISH on 14<sup>th</sup> December 2010, I had worked as a regular employee of Cochin University of Science and Technology which is a Govt. of Kerala autonomous body for the period from 9<sup>th</sup> March 2001 to 2<sup>nd</sup> July 2007. I was subsequently transferred to Calicut University under the state universities mutual transfer scheme for the period from 3<sup>rd</sup> July 2007 to 13<sup>th</sup> December 2010. Total service rendered at both universities is 9 years and 9 months.
- 2. Both the universities are autonomous bodies working under the state government and covered under old pension scheme for those employees who joined prior to 01.01.2004.
- 3. Since my initial appointment was in 2001, I was covered under the old pension scheme in both the universities.
- 4. It may be noted that the application for the position of Library and Information Officer at AIISH was sent through proper channel and I was relieved from the service of Calicut University on 13<sup>th</sup> December 2010 upon selection to the said post (*Copy enclosed*).
- 5. In the OM No. 28/30/2004-P & PW (B) dated 28<sup>th</sup> October 2009 of the Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances and Pension, Govt. of India, it is stated that personnel moving from Central Government/Central Government autonomous bodies to State Government / State Government autonomous bodies and vice versa on or before 31.12.2003, and who are already covered under the old, non-contributory Pension Scheme of the respective governments are required to be extended with the benefit of Pension Rules applicable to the organization/Government. But the respective government is *required to discharge its liability by pro-rata retirement benefits to the respective*

government/autonomous bodies to which the employee is moving / moved on his selection for which one had applied through proper channel. (Copy of the

OM enclosed)

In the light of the above, I request you to consider my past service rendered at both

universities for pensionary benefits and to place my service under old pension scheme of

AIISH. Also, I request you to take up with the matter with the both universities to obtain

and remit the pro-rata retirements benefits to the AIISH account.
