Shaun R. Harper's research examines race and gender in education and social contexts, equity trends and racial climates on college campuses. Black and Latino male student success in high school and higher education, and college student engagement. He also occasionally writes about intercollegiate athletics. Dr. Harper has published 12 books and more than 60 peer-reviewed journal articles and other academic publications. He has received over \$11.4 million in research grants.

Several education associations have praised Professor Harper's scholarship, including the American Educational Research Association (2010 Division G Early Career Award, 2014 Relating Research to Practice Award); Association for the Study of Higher Education (2008 Early Career Award); National Association of Student Personnel Administrators (2004 Dissertation of the Year Award, 2010 Outstanding Contribution to Research Award, 2012 Robert H. Shaffer Award for Faculty Excellence, 2013 Pillar of the Profession); American College Personnel Association (2005 Emerging Scholar Award, 2009 Annuit Coeptus Award, 2014 Contribution to Knowledge Award); and the National Association of Academic Advisors for Athletics (2008 Excellence in Research and the National Award).

The New York Times, Los Angeles Times, Washington Post, USA Today, Wall Street Journal, Sports Illustrated, Chronicle of Higher Education, Inside Higher Ed, and numerous other media outlets have quoted Dr. Harper and highlighted his research. He has appeared on CNN, ESPN, CBSAN, NPR, and dozens of ABC, CBS, Fox, and NBC local news programs across the U.S.

Dr. Harper earned a bachelor's degree in education from Albany State, a historically Black university in Georgia, and his Ph.D. in higher education from Indiana University.

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**Description**  
香港人口急速老化，65歲以上的老年人口將在未來三十年佔總人口的四分之一，如要確保長者的生活質素，以及提升該老耆的照顧能力，將會是未來香港社會的挑戰。過去十年，各政府部門、醫管局、大學、專業團體和社會服務機構，都致力發展和研究有關老年健康的課題，藉以提升長者的生活、認知、心理和社交健康。近年，很多位西方人的治療研究，亦被嘗試應用在不同類型的疾病上，例如：情緒治療、多感官治療、音樂治療和認知行為治療等，但應用在華人身上的研究，則待更多的探索。華人社會一向重視家庭和親朋關係，以及勤奮工作的文化，大部份長者的教育水平偏低，亦會受到日常繁瑣工作，減少時間、金錢、認知、體力及社交機會的掣肘，故需大量的跨文化及專業合作來配合。打麻雀、打羽毛球、老耆健體和康樂等，香港治療單位長者過往較少接觸的活動中，發展出來的一套具有本土特色而採用藥物治療的方法，原來在融入長者的日常生活中，達到提供娛樂活動，亦同時提升長者的身體、認知、心理和社交功能。傳統的中國文化，一直重視所謂「打麻雀能醫百病」、「打麻雀是一種心靈寄托」、「打麻雀可以使人忘記煩惱，消除一切苦悶」，而每場牌局和入場費，打麻雀「博命」已成為一種習習及的娛樂活動。最近，有團體以及一些醫生均提出打麻雀有助老年人避免患上心理疾病，以及減輕老年痴呆症患者的退化症狀。然而，上述的觀點至今仍未有科學為證的。在2004年，仁濟醫院社會服務部為嶺南大學亞太老年學研究中心，採用科學化的研究方法，於仁濟醫院社會服務部轄下八間老人院舍中，選取121位患有輕度及中度認知能力受損的長者進行康樂治療的研究。研究的目的希望引導香港治療能改善長者老年痴呆症長者的身體、認知、心理和社交功能；並找出一套具策劃及有效執行的康樂治療模式，為該研究的持續和推廣，香港治療能成為一套具本土特色的康樂治療工具。我們期望藉此研究而得，為長者一展提供多一個康樂活動的治療選擇；同時亦希望本手冊能協助護理人員正的工作，改善病人主觀認知健康程度和實行康樂治療，造福廣大的社會。
