Animoto

[Animoto](#) is a digital video tool, which allows you to create a video using images, video clips, music and text.

B

Blabberize

[Blabberize](#) is a tool which turns an image into an interactive/animated presentation clip.

Blendspace

[Blendspace](#) is a digital tool and app which creates digital interactive lessons using a wide range of web content, file types and features.

Blog Ideas Generator

HubSpot's [Blog Ideas Generator](#) allows you to generate ideas for creative writing or blog posts based around themes or key words.

It can be useful for anyone creating accessible content or working on media/ marketing projects.

Box

[Box](#) is an online file storage, sharing and collaboration tool.

It allows you to save and access files remotely, and you can also work on documents and projects with others.

Bubbl

[Bubbl](#) is a tool for brainstorming and mind mapping online. Easy to share and good for class discussions.

Cite This For Me

[Cite This For Me](#) is a useful digital tool which will provide guidance with generating citations for various types of digital content. However, it may vary, so worthwhile checking over references with your lecturer or a member of Learning Centre staff.

ClassDojo

[ClassDojo](#) is a free digital classroom which allows teachers to create and share communications and learning with both parents and students. It includes messaging, story feeds to update about activities, achievements and events, and allows students to create a portfolio.

Classflow

[Classflow](#) is an all-in-one platform for delivering interactive lessons with embedded content.

Combines a presentation tool with a student response system, for a variety of class and learning styles.

Code Academy

[Code Academy](#) is a free MOOC style online course which offers quick practical sessions teaching how to code and designed to have instant results.

It includes courses on: HTML; CSS; JavaScript; jQuery; Python; Ruby; PHP; APIs.

Coffitivity

[Coffitivity](#) is a white noise generator - for those who find it calming, this can help enhance productivity. You can also control intensity of sound.

CoSchedule

[CoSchedule](#) is a headline analyser tool for those producing online content and interested in improving marketing, traffic and SEO.

Type your headline for digital content into the analyzer and it will score it and help you strengthen your marketing technique.

Crossword Labs

[Free tool](#) to create a crossword for teaching and learning activities.

DigitalLearn

[DigitalLearn](#) is offers free online refresher courses and classes on everything concerning IT - from Cloud storage and sending emails to Microsoft Office and social media.

Diigo

[Diigo](#) is a research companion app - a web extension tool which is linked to browser activity, allowing you to collect and organise information as you research.

It also allows students to highlight, annotate, tag and save information, which is then accessible online from anywhere.

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Doceri

[Doceri](#) is an interactive whiteboard app for creation and presentation on the iPad (or Apple devices). It will also screencast content remotely.

Doodle

[Doodle](#) is a digital polling tool which allows you to schedule events or activities by assessing which options work best for a large group of people.

You can also integrate existing calendars to enable better planning.

Dropbox

[Dropbox](#) is a cloud-based file storage application that allows you to back up data, documents, photos and more online.

Duck Duck Go

Search engine which doesn't track your activity online, promising less ads and spam, and quicker, more efficient searching.

[Edmodo](#) is a digital classroom tool which allows the creation of groups, activities and assessments.

EdWordle

An online word cloud generator. It creates a word cloud image with words and terms you enter. A great way to quickly highlight key concepts and topics visually.

Flipgrid

[Flipgrid](#) is a free tool for flipped classroom and social learning. Create a digital space to share and interact with students.

Formative

[Formative](#) is an interactive teaching tool to create, deliver and assess online learning content. Suitable for 1:1, flipped or blended classrooms, and BYOD.

Glogster

[Glogster](#) is a multimedia tool which allows you to create a multimedia interactive poster - combining images, graphics, audio, video and text on one digital canvas.

It also has an iPad app.

GoConqr Quiz Maker

[GoConqr](#) is a free online quiz maker which allows you to create and share quizzes.

Google Docs

[Google Docs](#) is a digital word processing application which allows you to create, access, edit and share documents anywhere.

It also includes comment tools, editing and chat functions to allow group collaboration in real time.

Nimbus Capture is a handy digital tool for advance screenshot techniques.

It allows you to capture the visible part of a screen, specific areas, a selected scroll of content, an entire window; it allows for flexible capture and manipulation of images. You can also edit and add notes, print and save.

OER Commons is a public digital library of open access educational resources.

It also offers interactive lesson creation tools and opportunities to share content.

Penflip

Penflip is a free collaborative writing tool. It allows you to create, share and download different file format documents and e-books online.

Penultimate
