GUIDELINES FOR PREPARATION AND SUBMISSION OF ABSTRACTS

Preparation of Abstract

- 1. Must be an original clinical/research work carried out by the authors themselves
- 2. There is no limit to the number of abstracts an author may submit
- 3. Abstracts that appear to be the replica versions of a single study will be rejected
- 4. Abstracts containing identical or nearly identical data submitted from the same institution and/or individuals will be rejected
- 5. The maximum word limit is 1200
- 6. The abstracts should have clearly defined sections as follows:
 - a) Title (Use Capitalize each content word format; to be in bold and centralized)
 - b) Introduction and Need
 - c) Aim and Objectives
 - d) Method
 - e) Results and Discussion
 - f) Summary and Conclusion
- 7. Font: Times New Roman
- 8. **Font size:** *Title of the Paper*: 14, *Abstract*: 12, *Key Words*:10
- 9. Plagiarism Check: Plagiarism report to be submitted. The similarity should not be $\geq 20\%$
- 10. Authors Name and their affiliation along with the title of the study to be submitted in a separate document
- Note: Tables, figures, bibliography are not required. Also, do not include the authors name or institute name in the abstract

Last date for Submission of Abstracts

- a) The last date for submission of abstracts is 30th November 2023 till 11 PM
